A Glimpse of Events near Previous Blood Moon Tetrads on Passover and Tabernacles

1493-94: In 1492, around the same time Columbus sailed to America, King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella signed an edict ordering all Jews to convert to Catholicism or be expelled from Spain.

1949-50: Fulfilling Ezekiel 37:1-14, nation of Israel reborn on May 14, 1948.

1967-68: In the Six-Day War, June 5-10, 1967, Israel captured the Sinai Peninsula, Gaza Strip, West Bank, Golan Heights, and the Old City of Jerusalem.

tetrad is a series of four total lunar eclipses with no partial lunar eclipses in between.



The 7 Feasts of the LORD and the 4 Blood Moons

Understanding the Historical and Prophetic Significance

The Past Meets the Future

The 7 Feasts of the LORD have both historical and prophetic meanings. Historical in that they point back in time to remind us of what God did for the Jewish people in the time of Moses, 1500 years before the birth of Jesus. Prophetic in that they point forward to a time they would be fulfilled by Messiah. Jesus fulfilled the first four spring/summer Feasts in his first coming. He will fulfill the final three fall Feasts in his second coming. The 7 Feasts of the LORD are:

1. Passover

Historically points to when the Passover Lamb was slain to protect a family from the Death Angel in Egypt.

Prophetically, Christ our Passover Lamb was slain for the sins of the world (1 Corinthians 5:7).

2. The Feast of Unleavened Bread

Historically points to when the children of Israel left slavery in Egypt in haste with no time to let bread rise. In the Bible leaven often symbolizes sin.

Prophetically, Jesus Christ, who

was without sin, was buried and in the grave for the first day of this Feast (2 Corinthians 5:21).

3. The Feast of First Fruits

Historically commemorates and thanks God for the first of the harvest after the Israelites entered the Promised Land.

Prophetically, Jesus Christ is the first of the harvest, the first raised from dead (1 Corinthians 15:20, 23, Revelation 1:5).

4. Pentecost

Historically, commemorates the giving of the Law by God to Moses.

Prophetically, commemorates, after Jesus ascended to heaven, the giving of the Holy Spirit poured out on Pentecost (Acts 2).

5. The Feast of Trumpets

Also known as *Yom Teruah* or *Rosh HaShanah*, historically, is associated with the blowing of the shofar (ram's horn trumpet).

Prophetically is connected to the resurrection of the dead and/or the Rapture (1 Corinthians 15:51-52, 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17).

6. The Day of Atonement

Also known as *Yom Kippur*, the High Priest carried blood into the Holy of Holies to atone for the people's sins. On this day every fiftieth year the Year of Jubilee is proclaimed.

Prophetically, Jesus Christ will come again to get his people whose sins are atoned for (Hebrews 10:19-21, Mark 15:37-38).

7. The Feast of Tabernacles

Also called the Feast of Booths or *Sukkot/Succot*, historically celebrates the completion of the harvest.

Prophetically, the harvest of souls from the earth is complete and God will come to live or "tabernacle" with His people (Revelation 14:15-16).
